An enchanting display

The Bellagio Conservatory, located at the heart of the Strip, features an enchanting display that captures the essence of winter. With fresh pink and red poinsettias, a 21-foottall holiday wreath and other fine creations. visitors strolling through this attraction will definitely get into the holiday spirit.

"Bellagio's Conservatory is a must-see attraction known worldwide and free for people of all ages," said Andres Garcia, assistant director of horticulture.

The Conservatory would not be complete without its towering holiday tree. Adorned with 12,000 colorful lights and twinkling jewels, the 32-foot-tall Shasta fir tree makes the perfect centerpiece. The "floating" gigantic ornaments surrounding the tree provide the finishing touch.
